The NWCOA Wildlife Control Business of the Year Award recognizes two wildlife control businesses annually for their outstanding accomplishments in the industry and their community. In the case of insufficient nominations in any category, the Awards Committee reserves the right not to name a category winner.

Eligibility: Nominees:

- must be a current member in good standing with NWCOA;
- must have been in business a minimum of three years; and
- must have more than 51% of business revenue from wildlife control.

NWCOA Wildlife Control Micro Business of the Year

This award is for companies with up to five (5) employees at a single location.

NWCOA Wildlife Control Macro Business of the Year

This award is for companies with six (6) or more employees.

Process:

Each nominated company that meets eligibility requirements will receive an application and letter explaining the process. Completed applications are due to NWCOA by November 30, 2018.

All completed applications will be reviewed by the selection committee, who will make their decision based on the information provided by the nominee company in the following categories:

- Increase in Sales and/or Unit Volume: Nominee will provide information indicating continued growth.
- Staying Power: Nominee will provide a brief company history and describe their major products and/or services. They will include any responses to adversity as an established business.
- Growth in Number of Employees: Nominee will describe the impact of the business on the job market.
- Innovativeness of Product or Service Offered: How is the business unique or innovative?
- Contributions by Business to Community-Oriented Projects: Nominee will describe ways in which the business has contributed to the community to overcome social or environmental problems.

The selected award recipients will be announced at the Awards Banquet at the Wildlife Expo in Myrtle Beach, SC on February 8, 2019.
